Memorandum for the Record

Subject: Fritz Paul SCHWEND

1. The following information on Subject was obtained by

during a meeting with Mr. Charles Siragusa, Assistant Director Federal Bureau of Narcotics, on 1 February 1963.

2. The Secret Service has an extensive file on Subject in view of his WW II involvement in counterfeiting. Subject currently is in Lima where he is the service department manager of Motor Import, S.A., the Volkswagen firm in Peru. The Italian government still has an outstanding extradition order against Subject for a charge of murder which was committed during WW II.

3. While Siragusa was in Lima in early December 1962 he tried to develop information on Subject and interview him through the Foreigners Division of the Peruvian Investigation Police. Siragusa was not to develop any worthwhile leads as to Subject's present current activities. Also PIP informed him that Subject was collaborating with the National Intelligence Service (SIN). Therefore, was reluctant to set up any interview for Siragusa.

4. Following is the information obtained from Siragusa on Subject (which he obtained from PIP):

DOB: 20 June 1908

Entered Peru 1954 from Panama

Lives at Kilometer 17, Vitarte (Quilicura) of Lima

German FP 92-3302238/53 issued 14 April 1953 at the German

Consulate, Quito.
