| Iraq in the past three years has sought foreign equipment and chemicals <br> that would give it the capability to produce chemical warfare (CW) <br> agents for a limited strategic stockpile, | probably to replenish its pre-Gulf war CW precursor stockpile and to restore its ability to produce nerve agents. Iraqi entities have sought dualuse precursors in the EU, the Middle East, Asia, and Australia, but the status of the negotiations and the intended use of the materials are unknown.

Al Tareq probably is connected to Iraq's CW program and could be converted quickly to CW precursor production.
