37. Subject was first introduced to [] In April '51 as a potentially capable man. He was first hired in June 1951 to examine possibilities of nets and balloon operations across the demarcation line in Germany.
38. Subject is being handled through [] Any good case officer could deal with him through []
39. Vlassovite (Gen. Vlassov's adjutant), sincere anti-Bolshevik. Loves adventure and interesting deals.
40. Name traces made with Wash, COS, ELS, CLB in May 1951 with negative results.
41. Little control now exists. Control could be increased if subject were to work with some American on an operational level.
42. AIS
43. None
44. Subject has not yet been used on an operation.
45. Subject's duties will probably consist of running a propaganda distribution net across the demarcation line.
46. None
47. Not applicable at present.
48. Salary of about 350 DM's per month.
49. None
50. Might possibly pass as a Volkdeutsche. German is fluent but with a noticeable accent.
51. Father was an Admiral (executed).
52. Subject loves the black market and plays it with rare skill. Apparently not over addicted to women or liquor; is married and has a child.
53. Subject is a combination of a sincere anti-Bolshevik and a black-marketeer. He is an exceedingly capable worker. Appears reliable and reasonably secure in anti-Bolshevik activities.
54. Might possibly work for German intelligence. As a Vlassovite he once accepted German aid, and to work for a democratic Germany against the USSR would be more agreeable to him than working with Hitler.
55. Subject is very sharp. His ability to mix with all sorts of people and to conclude all sorts of deals might make him a good net man.
