### AUGITICHAL BIOGRAPHICAL DATA ON DERGET LYOVICH SHEBALIN

antonov, Restislav, Lvovich, later changed to SHERALIN, Sergei Lvovich, was form on 30 Rovember 1920 in Laningrad, USBR. Subject legally changed his name from ARTONOV to SHEELIN in June 1950 at "Amt fur Kriminaltechnische Statistik" in kunich, Germany, and is currently using this name. In order to avoid forced reparation to the USBR he used the name of Sergel Freulish for several weeks in key or June 1945.

From September 1929 to June 1937, subject attended the 14th Middle School which was located at Mohoveya Ulitas 26, Loningrad, USSR. Upon completion of the 7th year at this school the whole class was transferred to the 19th Middle School which was also located on Mohovaya Ulitsa. Subject completed his eighth year here. The minth and tenth year of schooling was completed at the 28th Eiddle School on Mirochnaya Ulitar, Leningrad, USSR. Subject was graduated from the 10th grade with the highest grade in a class of a prox. 30 students and received the Solotoy atistat. In September 1939 he enrolled in the Leningrad alectro-Technical Institute and studied here for three months. At this time he became eligible for the draft during the Finnish an and in order to avoid military service in the Infantry, subject enrolled in the 3rd Leningrad Artillery School in November 1939. Subject remained in this school till September 1941. The 3rd Leningrad artillery chool was located in a large compound (1 city block) at Viborg and Katereshnaya at., Leningrad. During the summer this school went into the field at luga approx. 110 or 120 22 southwest of Leningrad. During the summer of 1941, while in the field with the school, subject took part in several buttles.

In September 1941 subject was graduated from this school as a Lt.

In September 1941 subject was transferred to Roscow thence to Alabino approx. 30 A southwest of koscow. At Albino subject took a short course in rocket artillery. This course lasted from September to November 1941. while taking this course, 7 regiments of rocket artillery were formed here. Subject was assigned to the 5th Guards Rocket Launching assignedt. This regiment was broken up into 3 companies. Subject was assigned to the 2nd separate company. This company was sent to the front at Kharkov and remained there till ecember 1961. Subject was Chief of Staff of Company Hq. and was promoted to Sr. Lt. in Dec. 1941. He remained as Chief of Staff till the summer of 1942. In the summer of 1942, subject sesumed command of the 3rd Separate Guards Hocket Launching Company and was promoted to Captain. He received the Red Star for action near kupyansk on the Don. In 15 Aug. 1912, while crossing the Don River at Perepolar village, subject took his division across the river through the German lines and engaged the German tanks. Subject was in a barn when a Jerman tank hit the barn and he was buried in the debris. The Germans rescued him and took him to the Hq. of the German division. From biy. Hq. at place of capture, he was transferred to Army Hq. at Kharkov, then to Vinnilsa near the Rumanian-Folish torder in the South Ukraine. Subject was placed in an Interrogation comp and immediately got acquainted with Vlassov. Approx. 30 selected Ph's were at this camp. Subject remained at this camp for one month. While at this camp, Ylassov discussed with subject the possibility of formation of a muscian army to fight against the Communists. In Nov. 1942 Shebalin and 7 or 8 other Fi's were transferred to a FR camp at Hammelburg, north of Nurnberg near Rosenheim. Subject remained here till January 1943. In January 1943 he was assigned to o glass factory at Furt-in- ald as a common

laborer. In april or way subject was transferred to Leutzin in East Prussia. Here the formation of the Mussian army was in progress. Subject was assigned as Chief of Fersonnel. Vlassov arrived here in May 1943 and a few days later departed for Eerlin. While at this camp Vlassov notified subject that he was to be Vlassov's adjutant. A few days after Vlassov's departure for Berlin subject was ordered to report to Vlassov in Berlin.

Shortly after subject's arrival in Berlin, Vlassov took him on a speaking tour in German occupied USSE. This trip lasted approx. 3 weeks. In June 1943 subject returned to Berlin.

The Germans turned over a villa in Berlin at 9 Kibitzweg as Vlassov's quarters. The organization of the Hussian Army began here. From 1943 to Feb. 1945 the Hq. w.s located in Berlin. During subject's stay in Berlin he met Goebbels, Ribentrop, Gorring, Bones Raeder, Himmler. All meetings were official, and subject was present because he was Vlassov's adjutant. In March 1945 subject was transferred to Karlsbed Seudetenland. Here he continued this position as adjutant to General Vlassov.

while still in Serlin subject mot Ulia VORCHNO, who was brought to Germany by the German Army. Subject wanted to marry Ulia VORCHNO but due to very strong objection of General Vlassov the marriage never took place.

Vlassow's Hq. remained in Earlsbad for approx. two weeks. From Karlsbad the Hq. was moved to Kozoyedy, Czech., 60 KM west of Frague. Vlassow's Aq. was baded here with the 1st Russian Div. of the German Army.

In May 1945 subject was ordered by Vlassov to go as Vlassov's representative to the U.S. Aray Hq. at Filsen, Cxech. Vlassov wanted subject to request permission from the U.S. Command to let Vlassov's division through the U.S. lines. Subject conferred with the Deputy Chief of Staff of the U.S. forces, name unknown. The Col. informed subject that the div. could come through as FW's. Subject returned to Vlassov's Hq., reported the offer and again returned to the U.S. Army G.G., through a representative, offered to let Vlassov's division be safely conducted through the U.S. lines with the following stipulation. All members of Vlassov's division were to put on civilian clothes and make their way into Germany. Once in Germany they would then be on their own. Vlassov refused this offer.

Soon after this Vlassov moved his Hq. to Schlosselburg, Czech., 35 KK SE of Filsen. Here members of Vlassov's div. began to surrender to the U.S. forces. The surrenders were in small groups, not en masse.

On the way to the U.S. Army Mq. Vlassov's automobile convoy was stepped by a Soviet unit and the party was placed under arrest. Two of the cars in this convoy made a getaway. Subject was in one of these cars. As soon as subject got to the U.S. lines he was given provisions and furnished transportation to a wooded section of the country approx. 30 KM east of the German border at Eisenburg. The Americans transported subject and six other Vlassov Army members through the Soviet lines in a covered truck.

Subject and the rest of the group made their way through the woods to the U.S. Acne German border. The border was crossed near sisonburg. From Eisbaherg subject went to Deggendorf. Here a verman achool teacher issued false identity papers to subject. This identity paper listed subject as a vierman school teacher and was made out in the name of frohlich, werge. From Degrandorf source ment to Traunatein 90 KM of Munich. From Traunatein subject went to dempten. Upon arrival at hempten subject regintered at the wittelsbacher Schule, a write auzaian refuges center. Here nubject used the mame of SHEBALIN. Two sets of documents were issued, one in the name of SHEBALIN, the second in the name of .NITONOV. Subject spent approx. one week in this camp and departed for Kaltenbach in the U.S. one, Austria. The reason for this trip was to locate Ulia, his girlfriend from Berlin. Soon after locuting Ulia VCHONNO, both of them departed for Fewpton. Upon arrival at Kompton, VURONEO received papers in the name of ANTOHOVA and lived us his common-law wife. Due to the fact that the U.S. authorities began to turn over Post citizens to the Soviets, subject and his common-law wife excaped to havensburg, Vangen, and several other cities in the france wone of Garmany. Approx. Five days were spent in the French Aone, then they returned to Kenpten. After a two day stay in the woods adjacent to Kempten, subject secured a room at 46 Brahgasse Str. Kempten. Subject and VORONKO resided at this address till the winter of 1946. While here subject made his living on the local black market. In the winter of 1946 Ulis ANTENOVA nee VORNHAA departed for Sunich. Joon ofter, subject followed to Munich and they set in the vicinity of the German Numeum. Subject was arrested by the U.S. MF's during this rendezvous. The reason for the arrest was that Ulia ANTONOVA informed the police that subject was a Aussian Nazi and served as Vlassov's adjutant. Subject was confined in the folice Presidium in Munich for 3 days. Frior to Ulis ANTONOVA's departure from Kempten, she informed the Semptem police that her billets were broken into and her belongings were stolen. The Kempten police upon investigation determined that nothing of the sort had occurred. then subject was upprehended in Funich, he was charged with making a false report to the hempton police. He was tried by the "Schnell Gericht" and found not guilty. The .merican all officer and arrested subject informed the court that subject, according to the available information, was a Russian Razi. As a result of this charge, subject was placed in the "Stadleheim jail". He spent one menth in confinement and was brought to tral in a U.S. court (Regular Military Seriht). Verdict - not guilty. He was freed. The trial took place in Rovember 1346. Subject returned to Rempten. He secured official employment with "Electro Anlagen" as a technical draftemen. This fire was a cover for a black market activity dealing in opinits and apples. Subject married Tatiana afonssiyevna HAUR in Rempton in august 1947. T. RAUN remided in Biberah, Fr. one, Germany, before her marriage. RAUN left the USSR in 1943

In the fall of 1947, approx. in vetober, source was again arrested by the Geman Criminal Folice. The charge was possession of three sets of identity documents in three different names with the same photo and the receipt of ration cards on these false documents. Subject explained the situation to the police and was released without trial. Here subject destroyed all the identity cards except the one in the name of SHESALIM.
