He was seventeenth on the list of Lt-Generals in 1942. 6 In March 1942 he left the post of commandant of the Military Staff College, where he was succeeded by General Oliabs Economics, and was appointed commander in chief of the Thirteenth Army of Shraghai. In March of 1944 he ras succeeded in that post by Lt-General EAGATSU Scioligo, and was appointed Commander of the Western District Army, succeeding General FUJIE Reisules In that position he roved to strongthen the defencive attracture of the Army. Much was expected of him because of his background as corps commander on the continent and because he had had much combat experience. 8/ This last statement is opposed by a later source who says that he had had virtually no field

In November of 1944 he was succeeded by Lt-General YOMOYAMA Isamu as communder of the Western District Army and SHIMDMURA was appointed Commender of the North China Ares Army, succeeding General OKABE Haosaburo. 1/

He was promoted to full general at the same time as KIMURA Hyotore and TOSHIMOTO Telichi. 6/

On 23 August 1945 he was appointed Minister for War in Prepier HIGASHI-KUHI Haruhiko's Cabinet, succeeding the Premier who had held the post of War Minister concurrently. 8/5/Lt-General NEMOTO Hiroshi succeeded him as commander of the North China Area Army on 25 August

He is reported by several sources to be one of the outstanding authorities on European conditions, 1/5/ and his name has been linked with General PUJIE in this connection. I
