<p>SHIMOMURA was board chairman of the <u>Kaiko Kai (Army Officers Society)</u>, of which he was one of the founders, until May 55. <u>SUGIIE Takao</u>, now president of the <u>Kaiko Kai</u>, was recommended for the post by SHIMOMURA. He also serves as an adviser to the <u>Wippon Seno Gunjin Kai (Japan Disabled Veterans Association)</u> and ex-Lt Gen DOI Akio's <u>Heiwa Mondai Kenkyukai (Continental Problems Research Institute)</u>. He was a charter member of the <u>Oshi Kurabu (Cherry and Star Club)</u>, which acted as a liaison unit for veterans organizations throughout Japan and unified them into a single national veterans organization in Jun 55. He also holds membership in the <u>Kokuh Gakka (National Defense Deliberation Society)</u>, which is attempting to propagate among the Japanese people an awareness to the need for national defense, and in the <u>Kurabu Kai</u>, a small group comprising about fifty graduates of the former Military Academy. SHIMOMURA has reportedly agreed to cooperate with the <u>Ayukoku Kokumin Seisaku (National Salvation Peoples Federation)</u>, leaders of which hope to use him and other prominent figures as a front for their ultranationalist activities.</p>
