SUBJECT: SI and H Experimentation, 24 February 1953.

On Tuesday, 24 February 1953, [redacted] and the writer conducted SI and H experimentation and tests with [redacted]. As mentioned previously, [redacted] who is not a good subject, was not used in the testing but was used mainly in the capacity of an observer and to help control some of the experiments.

Since [redacted] had shown an increasing ability in the work, several advanced experiments in "normal movement", PH suggestions, and amnesias were carried out during this session. Both [redacted] operating individually, were able to move all over Building 13, carry on normal conversations, respond to numerous tests and in each instance had definite amnesias for the total activity during each test. Since these tests were quite complicated, involving extensive movement, extreme questioning, eyes opened and closed at various times and lasted in each instance between 30-40 minutes. The fact that both subjects were able to obtain a good amnesia is regarded as quite significant. Tests were also run during the evening involving control, using a control system involving [redacted] who definitely has no H ability. In addition to the above, both subjects showed a very high capacity for reacting to PH suggestions.

For matter of record, it would appear at this point that both [redacted] will become excellent subjects if they continue to work [redacted]. Both appear to be extremely interested and certainly appear to be capable of very advanced work. At this point, it should be noted that [redacted] is somewhat better than [redacted].
