On Tuesday, 10 March 1953, [redacted] and the writer conducted SI and H experimentation and tests with [redacted]. At this point, [redacted] and the writer officially that she was transferring from [redacted] and subsequently going overseas for the Agency. She stated she would like to continue the work and would maintain an interest in it even though overseas. The writer told [redacted] that after she had settled down in [redacted] here, if she would contact the writer, arrangements could possibly be made to continue the work here. The writer, however, cautioned her concerning the security problems involving the [redacted] work.

Thereafter, the writer and [redacted] showed [redacted] motion pictures previously made on other H subjects since [redacted] had never seen these before. The work was concluded by running some standard tests on illusion and hallucination both under full H and as PH suggestions.

As has been noted before, [redacted] not a good subject and appears to be interested in the work solely for overtime and not for real personal interest.
