Since this was in a sense still an exploratory operation all subjects were tested on hand levitation. As a rule this was not too successful.

Thereafter, all subjects were run by various operators on a slow, straight induction and awakening.

After a period of discussion, the subjects were again run on a slow induction method with the exception of [REDACTED] who was not handled in view of the fact that time was running short.

In general, this session was not too successful in the opinion of the writer and there were too many people working in too small an area which produced unusual curiosity and a certain amount of confusion in carrying out instructions. In addition, the inductions as a rule were run too slowly with a great deal of wasted talk and motion and far too much explanation to be productive of good results.
