On 3 March 1954, SI and H experimentation and research was carried on in Room 20, Building 13, by [REDACTED] using the following subjects: [REDACTED]

Routine tests and inductions and straight PH were tried throughout the evening's work. One special slow induction was given to assist [REDACTED] who apparently is slow in accepting H control.

The only unusual activity insofar as the work of the evening was concerned was that [REDACTED] were instructed to remain in a very deep slwmp state and [REDACTED] while in a sleep state with her eyes open was instructed to try to awaken the two sleepers. [REDACTED] tried by shaking and calling the names of both girls loudly without results and then apparently in exasperation dragged [REDACTED] out of the chair and let her fall to the floor in an effort to awaken her. This effort was unsuccessful. This seemed unusual in view of the fact [REDACTED] is very unemotional and while a good subject has not been aggressive in any of her work. For matter of record, [REDACTED] had not amnesia of the activity and clearly remembered pulling [REDACTED] from the chair. Also for matter of record, it should be noted that [REDACTED] was sleeping on the floor was partially fallen on by [REDACTED] when she was dragged out of the Chair but [REDACTED] remained asleep during the entire activity. The session closed at about 8:30.
