Subject: SI testing, 24 July 1951 (Rooms 20, 17).

On 21 July 1951, between 6:00 PM and 9:00 PM, and conducted SI and H experiments and tests with the rol lowing subjects:

After the usual general discussion, the firsttest was made. This test was to produce"normal" movement conversation and appearance in all subjects. Upon conclusion of the first test, another discussion was held after which the placed all three subjects in a deep trance. After the next room and the was finished, she was instructed to go into the next room and the was moved back into Room 20. created the hallucination for the wathat a glass of water was a strong Manhattan cocktail which promoted in an intoricated, hilarious effect. Thereafter and questioned carefully on personal matters with good results and joined the conversation very successfully and naturally.

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After was finished, she was instructed to move into Room 17 and was brought into Room 20. created the narriucination for that she was drinking and "Old Fashion" cocktail and stated she "felt" the cocktail, but did not become as intoxicated as did either or then questioned on personal matters in a normal conversational manner.

At the conclusion of this test, all subjects were given total amnesia which was entirely successful.

It should be noted that during this whole test, all subjects were kept under SI for the entire time (about 40-50 minutes) and during this period while a series of tests for depth, control, etc. including instructing and working of a "Kodak 35" in the loading and working of from the subject of this knowledge remember telling and about its working.)

Again as before at the conclusion of the second test, all subjects were briefed on the test and a discussion was held with the subjects on the final test of the evening. This test consisted of an attempt to have each subject, under SI, memorize in rapid time a short quotation by reading same from a book--thereafter, each subject would be removed from the trance state and moved into the adjoining room under post H control, where by agreement would return subject to the trance and have the subject write out. while under SI, the memorized text. On this test, executed the test without incident moved=normally during the post H period. However, was able to recall and write out the full text of her duotation prior to being placed under SI bei thereafter was placed under SI by and sne again wrote the quotation verbatim.

Comment:

With the exception of the unusual reaction of referred to above all the above tests were reas successful. However, both a general rule, many tests and considerable coaching is necessary before a subject can function while under SI in a completely "normal" manner.
