Buenos Aires, July 21 49.—A i opposition Congressman charged by inference (utly) that more than 30 newly arrived Germans, including a number of Nazi aviation experts, are in the employ of the Argentine government.

Silvano Saudtander, a member of the Radical Party, introduced a resolution asking the government to explain the situation. He made his charge in the form of a question and pointed out that Argentina still is technically at wat with Germany.

Santander mentioned three former German officers—SS (Ellia Guard) Col./ Otto/ Skovzony, warline resource of Mussoliul from the Badogilo Government of Italy, and two high ranking members of the German Air Force, Geo. Adolf. Gallanj and Col. Hans. Utrich Ruiter.
