1. Per ENGDAHL, the Swedish Fascist Leader, told [] upon return from his recent visit to Spain that Otto SCORZENY was no longer considered trustworthy by Spanish and international Fascists in Spain. Spanish Falangist officers told Engdahl that Scorzeny was no longer invited to important Fascist gatherings because he is believed to be in close contact with French and American intelligence officers or military attaches, to whom he reports every bit of information he receives on Fascist activities.
