SPECIFIC:

Liaison in Germany

1. There have been numerous suggestions that the Skorzeny Net is involved in the Platow Case. Zipper has shown that Wehlen and Schulz were both on the Platow payroll. Examination of the Platow material received through Caravel reveals only one name associated with the Skorzeny Net -- Dr. Sonnenhol. Copies of a Sicherungsgruppe interview of Sonnenhol are attached, along with a list of Bonn officials receiving money from Platow.

2. If the British exhibit no further interest in the Skorzeny affair, it is recommended that all our material be turned over to the VS with the suggestion that the members of the Skorzeny Net turned up by us and Zipper may be involved with Platow.
