In late August 195., Dr. Hobert FIATOT, publisher of the weekly (bi-monthly) economics information sheet "Mirtschaftskorrespondens," and his deputy, Dr. Arno HEGRICH, were arrested in HAMBIRG for the alleged bribery of a number of Pederal government officials. PLATON's arrest, as wall as some of the circumstances leading to it as well as a resume of PLATON's personal history, was described at length in a number of German newspapers, particularly by the political weekly "Der Spiegel."

As a whole, it is felt that the PLATOY case is not of direct interest to this writer, however, this writer has recently and occusion to glance at some of the original documents of the German arency most concerned with the security angle of the incident of the briberies, this same agency also caused PLATOR's arrest. Since these documents (classified SECRST), were too langthy for copying, the following is a resume of such notes as this writer was able to take "on the most," plus oral information taken from memory.

Dr. PIATOW, described as an intelligent, unscrupillous, self-made mand on opportunist, has, for several years, published a private information service pertaining to economic and industrial developments and planning in the Pederal Republic. The monoics conducting the investigation were fortunate in that a ledger was found in MATON's possession listing the names and addresses of a number of persons, in and out of government circles, to whom payments had been made periodically via postal money orders. It was found that PIATON paid as little as 5 DN for small items of news to a German "Putsfrau" (scrubwoman) who had recovered discarded items of information from the waste paper baskets of the Ministry. His highest paid informant, with a regular monthly salary of 500 DN, was Dr. phil. Guenter WEISER, born 20 September 1902 in WIRSEADEN, residing at Lotherstrasse \$16, BONN. Dr. KEISER is a Ministerial-direktor in the Ministry of Boonomics and the Chief of Sub-Division I-a (Flanning). He is a personal friend of Professor ERHARD, the Minister, who took him along on a recent business trip to the US as ERHARDS' advisor. It was revealed that Dr. KEISER undertook monthly "business trips" to HAMBERG in his official Merceres, which always ended at PLATON's apartment.

6. Following the arrest of FLATON and MEGRICH, and after it had become evident that the bulk of further inquiries would have to be conducted in MONE, the two individuals were moved to that city. investigation of the personalities mentioned above, pending receipt of a resplete report of investigative results promised this writer as soon as the prosecution has satisfied itself that all angles have been exploited in this case. These angles include the possibility, although presently believed not probable, that Dr. Platon was also engaged in collecting information for the gast-Zone government-connected intelligence agencies.
