2. SUBJ IS CONSIDERED CONTROVERSIAL IN VIEW OF HIS ACTIVI-  
TIES DURING HITLER REGIME. REPORTEDLY, HE WAS GERMAN FOREIGN  
SERVICE LIAISON OFFICER TO REICHSICHERHEITSAMT DURING NOV 1944  
TO MAY 1945. ACCORDING TO ONE VERSION RELATED BY CASTENO, SUBJ  
WAS ORDERED TO GENEVA IN COMPANY OF FELFE. APPARENTLY GERMANS  
HAVE NO GOOD INFO ON SONNENHOL'S ACTIVITIES IN GENEVA OR ELSE-  
WHERE DURING THIS PERIOD.
