- 2. According to NOSTRIL, C. I was born on 12 Parch 1927 in the village of High krop, Kropeki District, which is near Fallack. Subject, a Rabardine, was the son of Shammal and Majouat Gov. Subject's father, Shammel, was errested in 1937 and sentenced to ten years imprisonment in Siberia because of his opposition to 'callectivization. The family received letters from the father until 1960, but have beard nothing from him since then.
 - 3. Subject completed the fifth year of elementary school at Right hop in 1942, just prior to the German invasion. He remained in his village during the German occupation which lasted from September 1942 to Jamesry 1943. Subject and four of his brothers fled the Cancasus with the German in 1943. His brothers (a) Sachif and (b) Haj Burid are presently residing in Amen. The former is a gas station attendant and the latter is employed with the CAT Company. Another brother, (c) Feta, recently accepted a position with the cil company in Kanait, while (d) Sagh, the youngest of the five, is residing in the American Sone of Germany, near Munich. Subject and brothers (a) through (d) left their mother and four either sons in the Gaussus at the time of their flight and have heard nothing of the family since that time.

 The four brothers remaining behind with the mother, Fatomat, were (e) Zamarbek, age 12, (f) Lastelbek, 10, (g) America. 9. and (h) Tamerree, 5 (ages given are as of 1943). ECCTAIL also indicated that _______ Uncle, (the brother of ECSTRIL/2's mother), Rekvas Habekova, was deported with his family to Tambekut in 1937 because of charges that he was an obstructionist.
 - 4. Subject and his brothers retreated from the Caucasus through the Ukrains, Russnia, Hungary, Peland, Csechoslovakia, Austria, and finally to Italy.
 - 5. From November 1944 until the end of HW II, enhanced in Udina, Italy and served
