- A caroful check of meadquarters files revealed the following traces on one it. Johnst Veli men Januara we bolieve to be identical with the author of Hodfall's letter received from Argentina;
  - a. on 28 August 1947 an UPACTE staff employee, formerly associated with AUTRIM, received a letter in Russian from Lt. Colonel Velidek JEUIUAR (signed Velidedigar), 21 Redcliffs Square, London S.W. 10, who offered his services to ODYOKE. JETTAR explained in the letter that he had been a Colonel in a Cavalry Regiment in the Russian Army but that, like many Moslems all over Europe who had been former members of the Russian Army, he decided not to return to Russian but to work for the liberation of his people instead. He further stated that he was living in London and had to think of his future as he had a wife and child. He concluded the letter by remarking that he knew how to keep his gouth shut.
  - b. The recipient of the letter turned if over to NUTWIN with the comment that he had no idea who Colonel Jaildak was or who had given JaDidak his name, but he suradsed that it was someone who knew that he once worked for NUTWIN and who probably thought he still worked there. Additional comments made by the recipient on the spelling of JKBIGAK's name might be of interest to you and are as follows: "The 'Bek' stands for 'Bey' and in Osmanli Turkish he would be Veli Bey YAJIGAR, Veli Yadigar BEY or, today, Bay Veli YAIIGAR.
