On April 25, 1969, Mischael Chuako, 229 Clinton Street, Paterson, New Jersey, appeared at the Paterson Resident Agency of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and furnished an eight page statement prepared and signed by himself and others, which is attached as an appendix hereto, concerning the subject. He also furnished the following information:

MISCHIEF CHUAKO, 229 Clinton Street, Paterson, New Jersey, related the following:

CHUAKO was born November 4, 1911, Krasnodar, North Caucasus. He was taken by the German forces to the Ukraine. He subsequently went to Italy, Austria and Germany. CHUAKO remained in Germany until 1951, when he entered the United States. He was naturalized a United States citizen in 1961. CHUAKO is presently employed as the custodian at Wayne Hills High School, Wayne, New Jersey.

CHUAKO wanted the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to be aware of subject's past and present activities. He and the others have signed the statement concerning the subject and believe he has committed violations against the civil and moral laws.

CHUAKO, as well as many of the men who signed the statements concerning SOOBZOKOV, have known him from the Caucasus. CHUAKO lived about 17 miles from SOOBZOKOV in the Krasnodar area.

There are many Ciscaucasian people living in the Metropolitan New Jersey - New York area, who are terrorized by SOOBZOKOV because they know he is vicious.

SOOBZOKOV has the reputation among some Ciscaucasians of being a "swindler". SOOBZOKOV has created the impression that he can "fix" accident cases as well as divorce cases for Ciscaucasian people who live in Paterson, New Jersey area. He accepts money from people who are expecting some action on SOOBZOKOV's part. SOOBZOKOV has led people to believe he knows judges and political figures and therefore, SOOBZOKOV can take care of their problems. The money SOOBZOKOV has received is not declared as income by SOOBZOKOV.

SOOBZOKOV claims to be personally acquainted with ANTHONY J. GROSSI, leader of the Democratic Party of Passaic County and Representative CHARLES S. JOHNSON, Congressman of Passaic County in Paterson, New Jersey. Because of SOOBZOKOV's political activity on behalf of the Passaic County

Democratic Party, he was rewarded with appointments to the Paterson Zoning Board and is employed by the Passaic County Purchasing Department. Congressman JOHNSON recently appointed SOORZOKOV to head his "New Americans Program".

SOORZOKOV has developed friends in the local teamsters union since he was active in organizing the Universal Manufacturing Company, Paterson, New Jersey for the Teamsters Union.

There are people from the Caucasus living in the Paterson, New Jersey area, who are reluctant to say anything about SOORZOKOV because they fear he will physically harm them and/or cause them problems because he knows political figures. Should SOORZOKOV become aware that he, as well as the men who are listed as witnesses to the atrocities committed by SOORZOKOV, made above information available to authorities, SOORZOKOV would seek revenge.

TACHERIM SOOZEKOV

Tacherim Soozezov entered the United States on June 28, 1955, at New York City. He entered under the name Abdal Karim Showaboga. He was born August 24, 1924, Tachtamakni, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (USSR). He was naturalized April 17, 1961, Paterson, New Jersey, Certificate Number 7579444.

Gentlemen,

For the last couple years we are reading in news paper "Paterson News" articles about mr. Tscherim Soobzokov, 704 14th str. Paterson N.J. Several years ago, when we read a similar article in above mentioned paper, we did not react to it assuming that mr. Soobzokov must be known to U.S. immigration and naturalization authorities. But because, publishing articles in news paper, mr. Soobzokov is concealing the truth, we believe now that mr. Soobzokov may have not told the truth to U.S. Immigration and Naturalization officials and therefore we decided to give you some facts about mr. T. Soobzokov's activities in the past and at present time, which are as follows:

Mr. Tscherim Soobzokov was born in village Tachtamukay in Krasnodar region of USSR. In Summer 1942, when German army occupied Krasnodar region of USSR, mr. Tscherim Soobzokov voluntarily left his fathers house and voluntarily joined German occupation army. Couple of month later, approximately in fall 1942, mr. Soobzokov became a member of Nazi Execution Commando, which operated in Krasnodar region at that time. As member of that Commando, mr. Tscherim Soobzokov personally took an active part in raids of population centers in Krasnodar region during German occupation. Mr. Tscherim Soobzokov took an active part in arresting people and killing them without any kind of investigation or trial - fair or unfair.

From year 1943 to very end of World War II mr. Soobzokov was seen by many people in many different places in uniform of German State Security Forces. Mr. Soobzokov was not deported from his native country, he was not a transportation worker and mr. Soobzokov was not in a camp as slave laborer or prisoner during World War II.

For the last 6 - 7 years mr. Soobzokov is running a kind of unofficial employment agency - putting people to work, mainly in Universal Manufacturing Co. in Paterson, and charging them from \$100 to \$500 and more each time.

Mr. T. Soobzokov is running sort of unofficial law office too, pressuring people to entrust him with accident and divorce cases, for which he is getting paid \$500 to \$1000 and more. Here we are not talking about isolated cases.

Mr. T. Soobzokov is intimidating people, mainly refugees from USSR, who know some facts about his activities in the past and at present time, threatening them that he is a member of Masonic Lodge and anyone, who dares to say a word against him, will be taken care off quietly, efficiently and forever. Mr. Soobzokov personally made physical threat to several people.

With this report to you we hope we are taking a positive step to stop a former nazi murderer using his association with the city administration in Paterson N.J. and his membership in the masonic lodge to deceive, intimidate and create an atmosphere of fear among simple but innocent people.

All above statements are facts and we are prepared to provide evidence of witnesses.

Please investigate this matter as soon as possible.

I WON MY CASE IN COURT.

TRANSLATION OF MR. DANIL GASSOV'S STATEMENT.
(WE ENCLOSE ORIGINAL STATEMENT ON RUSSIAN).

I AM SIGNED BELOW AS MR. DANIL GASSOV, INFORMING
U.S. INVESTIGATION AUTHORITIES THAT I KNOW WELL
MR. TSCHERIM SOOBZOKOV. WHILE IN JORDAN MR. SOOBZOKOV
USED TO SHOW PALESTINE REFUGEE ARAB LEADERS
HIS DOCUMENTS WITH PHOTOS, CERTIFYING HIS MEMBERSHIP
IN NAZI EXECUTION COMMANDOS AND THAT HE WAS A
KILLER OF JEWS DURING WORLD WAR II, FOR WHICH
MR. T. SOOBZOKOV RECEIVED MATERIAL HELP FROM ARAB
LEADERS. I AM WITNESS OF MANY CASES WHILE IN
JORDAN MR. SOOBZOKOV TSCHERIM AND HIS BROTHER USED
TO COME HOME WITH FOOD PROVISIONS, WHICH THEY RECEIVED FROM
PALESTINE REFUGEE ORGANIZATIONS. IT WAS AFTER 1948.

FURTHERMORE, WHILE IN JORDAN I LIVED IN ONE ROOM
WITH TWO OTHER MEN BY THE NAME OF IDRIS EDYK & PASHA
EDYK FOR ABOUT FIVE YEARS. DURING THAT PERIOD OF TIME
I WAS WITNESS OF NUMEROUS CASES OF QUARREL, WHICH IN
SOME CASES DEVELOPED IN TO FIGHTS BETWEEN MR. TSCHERIM
SOOBZOKOV AND PASHA EDYK. IN MANY CASES MR. PASHA EDYK
REMINDED MR. T. SOOBZOKOV WHO HE WAS DURING WORLD WAR II
AND THAT MR. TSCHERIM SOOBZOKOV MANY TIMES CHALLENGED HIM
TO GO WITH MR. T. SOOBZOKOV TO KILL JEWS AND TAKE THEIR
BELONGINGS AND THAT AT THAT TIME MR. T. SOOBZOKOV WAS IN UNIFORM
OF GERMAN FIELD GENDARMERIE. IT WAS IN BUDAPEST, HUNGARY.
IN AFFIRMATION OF ABOVE STATEMENTS I SIGN BELOW. 9
