- 5. On Wednesday, 3 November 1953, between 7:00 and 9:30 PM a special demonstration in hypnosis was conducted by in Room 24, Building 13. Present at this demonstration were a group of representatives from and in addition individuals that had presentative participated in the hypnotic work. In addition, attended. No official count was made of those present but processly 25-30 people attended.
- talked for approximately 10-15 minutes at the start of the demonstration on hypnosis in general and then proceeded to give a series of demonstrations which he believed would be of interest to Security officers and the others present. In addition to answering many questions and demonstrating certain simple hypnotic processes. gave three main demonstrations: A) by the use or hypnosis, arranged with two good subjects. that if questioned in any way or manner on questions involving security, they would immediately go into a deep hypnotic state. This was very clearly and effectively demonstrated. B) demonstrated a good regression with with the subject going back to the age of ten. In this connection, it should be noted that in writing as she did at the age of ten wrote her name as which was her name before it had been changed by her explained that security codes could be built around the process of regression and messages could be conveyed in this manner using aregression technique to coneeal the message. C) demonstrated the possible transfer of control of a subject by showing that unless certain code words were used a good subject could or would under no circumstances recall the words or give them to anyone else.
