

1. The attached photostatted report was procured from CIC Region IV Headquarters on 10 October 1949, and since it contains information on the subject of WASHF-6056, has been forwarded for your information. ST TZNO has been an occasional source of Spec. Agt. John Spiegler, the author of the report, and turned in to his information on the Ukrainian emigration and on suspected Soviet agents in the American Zone of Germany. In late summer or early fall 1949, STETZKO succenly and inexplicably, from Spiegler's point of view, ceased cooperating and gave the impression that he would like to terminate this contact with American intelligence. Spiegler naturally interpreted this to that the summer of the contact with the series of the found another more fruitful contact. If id not confirm this suspicion and requested copies of this report on the basis of his known interest of two years standing in the Ukrainian emigration. No photograph of STETZKO, listed as Exhibit "A" on the photostat, was received from CIC.

2. If the information on STETZKO supplied by CARTEL 1, 2, and 3 is correct, he is not a mamber of UHVR, as stated in Para 5e, nor has he been in constant contact with anti-Soviet revolutionary elements in the Ukraine, as alleged in Para 12a. Otherwise the case officer is not aware of possible inaccuracies in this report.



7. Previous history: Subject was born on 19 January 1912 in TARMOPOL, Poland (Polish Ukraine - until 1939 the city of TALMOPOL

was a geographical part of Phland). Subject completed graumer and high school in TANNOPOL in 1929. Subject continued its studies at the universities of LYOW and ERAKOW. During this time he become a member of the O'DM (Organization of Uncainian Wationalists). As a university student Subject worked in the OUN headquarters for the West-Ukraine (commonly known as the Polish Ukraine) in LKOV. At this time he started with his first publications which were directed exeinst the Polish es well as the Bussian government. During the big famine in the Rast-Ukraine (commonly known as the Soviet Ukraine) in the years of 1932/33 Subject organized in the West-Diraine an anti-Soviet demonstration. This demonstration ended with the assessination of the Soviet commula general in LWOW, who was killed by one Wikolas LEWEK, a member of the Germans in 1942 in the Soviet Ukraine). Between the years 1931 and 1934 Subject was in charge of an OUN group, smuggling and distributing anti-Soviet propaganda material in the Soviet Ukraine. For his political activities, which were directed against the Soviet Union as well we against Foland Subject was arrested in 1934 together with Stepan Harder by the Polish political police and charged with commentracy against the Polish government. He and BAND'RA were tried by a Polish court and sentenced to five years imprisonment. However, in December 1936 Subject was given an amounty and was released from imprisogment. After his release Subject continued his political activities, which as before were directed against Poland and the Boviet Union. In consequence of these activities Subject was forced to live illegally. In 1937 Rugen KONOWALSTZ, at that time the leader of the CUN, appointed Subject to take charge of the ideological-political department of the Central Committee of the CUN (Eugen KCNOWALETZ was killed by the Communiate in ROTTERDAM, Holland, in 1938). Before the outbreak of the German-Polish war Subject and Stepsh EUNDEWA (who is the meantime escaped from a Polish prison and lived in hiding in LEOW) > were approached by Golomel Andrij RELETE, a leading Ukrainian politician, who suggested that the OUN should establish a contact with Garmany, Subject and BANDERA disagreed with MRLMYK'S proposal and broke their relations with MELNYK. After the outbreak of the German-Russian war and the occupation of the city of Life by Ukrainian insurgents, Subject presided the Ukrainian Metional Assembly and on 30 June 1941 proclaimed the restoration of an independent Ukrainian state. Subject formed the first provisional Ukrainian government, in which he held the position of the prime minister. At that time Stopen BANDORA was the supreme leader of the OUN and Subject his first representative. The first proclamation of the provisional Ukreinian government was the establishment of an Ukreinian army, which would fight against any power occupying the Ukraine. The govenment of Germany opposed this proclamation and gave the order to dissolve the provisional Ukrainian government. Subject in his especity as prime minister of this provisional movernment refused to comply with Garmany's order. On 13 July 1941 Subject was arrested by the Gestapo

in LHOW. After his arrest Subject was held for a short time in the Alexanderplats jail in HERLIN (N53/275), and later transferred to She concentration camp SAChSTMEAUSEN-CHARLENEURG. His co-inmates in the SACHSINGAUREN-GRANIKHBURG concentration camp were Stupen B. REPPA and the present French minister of education Yvon DVL:03. In Fall 1944 Subject and BASDERA were taken to BERLIN. In H. H. H. Hey were prequested to organize an Ukrainian Mational Curaittee, which would fight on the side of the Germans for the establish ant of an independent Ukrainian state. Subject and HAMDERA refused their cooperation on the German proposal. With the help of some OUN members Subject and BANDE A succeeded to escape from B. H.I.W. After the encape Bunject lived illegally for some time in KRANOW, Poland, then in BRATISLAVA, Cagnoboslovaria (at that time the capital city of Slovakia), and later in PRACUE, Greehonlovakie (at that time occupied by the Germans). In April 1945 Subject was errested again by the Gestapo in PRADUB and escorted to Garmany, However, the transport was attacked by an American airplane, and Subject was wounded. He was brought to a hospital is SUSICE, Oscehoslovakia (at that time occurred by the Germane). In June 1945 with the help of some OUN members Subject was brought to the American zone of Germany. In 1946 Subject was elected by the General Assembly of the (TH to become a member of the "Council of Three", consisting of Stepas BANDERA, Teras TSO:BUPYNIA, and Subject. The "Council of Three" is the supreme executive authority of the OUN (Organization of Victainian Mationalists) and of its army the UPA (Ukrainian Revolutionary Army). In April 1946 Subject was elected president of the Central Committee of the ABN (Anti-Bolshe-Vist Bloo of Nations). Since that date (April 1946) Subject stays most of the time in MUNICH (MA9/785), where on 10 April 1969 he organized the DP demonstration against the persecution of the church in the countries behind the iron curtain.

- 3. Enference to previous reports: Subject was previously reported in various reports in 1945, at which time the arrest of Stepan BiNDBiA was a priority mission of CIG. However, the information contained in Subject's dessiar File No. IV-4171 and in the cross reference dessiars Nos. IV-7027, IV-4490, IV-4596, IV-4932, IV-918.01, and IV-913.02 is out of date. Therefore a new investigation was initiated which resulted in the above findings.
- 9. Teason for investigation: Reference is made to PCK, dated 4 May 1949, from 00 7970th CIO Op Hq EU00M, Gp Ot 72, .ef.Nr.F-155, in which an investigation is requested concerning Jaroslaw STETZMO'S background, incluence and reliability.
  - 10. Results of investigation:

a. In the course of this investigation no devogatory information concerning Subject was found. A check of German police and other German agency records in the city of MUNICH was made with

negative results.

b. A check of 7970th CIO Group Hq. Ragion IV files was made with the following result: Dossier IV-4171 contrins a top secret letter from Ho. 970th CTO Detachment USPKT, AFO 757, dated 30 October 1946, File Ho. 350.09 (CIC/S-3/FG), Subject: ST/TSWO, Talcolley, He: IVS, file 350.09 (CRI/CIB/RE/700/9), dated 24 October 1946, To: Communing Officer CIC Region IV, AFO 205, US Army, storing that ST/TSWO, Talcolley, alias KARBOVITSCH, Zinoviy, is believed to be a Sowiet erent and a chief of the ABW organization, which is extremely unti-Seviet in its propaganda, but believed to be penetrated and amonaored by the poviets. Furthermore according to this letter, STEESO has one hand amounteted at the wrist. Between the date of the above mentioned "SFET letter (30 October 1946) and the present date (19 May 1949) the allegations that Subject is a Soviet agent and that the ABN is a Soviet-sponwared organization were dismoved. On the contrary, it was learned, that Subject as well as the organization ABN are extremely anti-Soviet. In the above mentioned UNFET letter Subject's mame is spelt as STEPSKO, Yeroslav, alias KARBOVITSCH, Zinoviy, however the correct spelling of Subject's same is STETZED, Jaroslaw, alies KAREOWYTECH, Zynowij. Furthermore the information that Subject has one hand asputated at the wrist is not encreet. Subject has no amputated hand, but mis left hand is oripoled.

- 11. Action taxen: None with this headquarters.
- 12. Comments:
- a. According to 0-0018-IV-Ho., who stands very near to Subject, Subject is in constant context with the anti-Boviet revolutionary elements within the Ukraina. Subject is the most radical fighter against Communism. In his sepacity as a member of the "Council of Three" of the GNN (Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists) and its army UTA (Ukrainian Pevo utionary Army) Subject is highly respected and influential not only among the Ukrainians, but also enough the emigration from other Soviet dominated countries. Furthermore according to 0-0018-IV-Hq. Subject is absolutely reliable, especially as far as his anti-Soviet attitude is concerned.
- b. Subject is using different aliases and false identity documents (see paragraph 4 of this report) for security reasons, as a fears that otherwise the Soviet authorities could locate him.
- o. A Photograph of Subject is attached to this report as Exhibit "A". This photograph shows Subject with a beard, however, Subject's beard is presently shaved.
- d. The above information with the exception of paragraph to of this report, was obtained by 0-0018-TV-Hg, through a direct
