1. Given below are texts of WT communications between the Latvian VALDEMAR station and the TIEBAR station. Texts were obtained from TILBURY via []

2. Texts are as follows:

- a. From VALDEMAR, 30 September: "IT IS RATHER DIFFICULT TO TRAIN A RADIO TELEGRAPHIST, BUT I HOPE THAT HE SOON WILL BE ABLE TO WORK INDEPENDENTLY. IF THERE IS ANY CHANCE, WE CAN SEND YOU ONE MAN, AND THERE ALSO MIGHT BE A POSSIBILITY THAT I COULD COME TO SWEDEN FOR DISCUSSIONS. WE ALREADY HAVE BEGUN TO LOOK FOR A SUITABLE LANDING SPOT."
- b. To VALDEMAR, 3 October: "CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR SUCCESSSES. DO YOU THINK THERE IS ANY CHANCE THAT YOU CAN SEND PEOPLE FROM THERE, OR IS IT ONLY POSSIBLE TO GET SOMEONE OUT BY HAVING US MAKE A PICK UP? IT WOULD BE WONDERFUL TO MEET YOU HERE IN SWEDEN."
