CARRIAGE Assessment of USAGS's Secretary (CC-3)

Reference- MA31-1677

1. We have little to add to [ ] excellent appraisal of CC-3 except a possible clarification of Subject's sensitivity to the question regarding German connections. It appears that she informed USAGS immediately after the CARRIAGE test that the question had bothered her because she had not been certain what she should say about her relations with one Christian CLEMM von Hohenberg. CC-3 lives in Salzburg with CLEMM and his family, and about a year ago USAGS instructed CC-3 to sound CLEMM out on the idea of working with USAGS as a trainer and debriefer. CLEMM is a former Abwehr officer, although he appears to have had no intelligence contacts since the war, and it is entirely possible that CC-3 considers elements of her contact with CLEMM to have been improper. At any rate, USAGS will be [ ] suggestions in mind, and he will devote more time to a gradual exploration of CC-3 personal contacts than he has in the past.

2. CC-3, incidentally, was much impressed with the CARRIAGE technique, approved wholeheartedly of its use and of [ ] sympathetic approach, and even coked with some evident anticipation when she would have to take it again.
