and the southern area under the management of <sup>San</sup> FURUKAWA, Chief of the Electrical Communications Section. It has also been said that ex-navy officer NAKINOTO <sup>San</sup> who had formerly been engaged in deciphering American codes, is being temporarily employed as a consultant. Ex-Lt. Colonel HIROSE Eichi, code expert and former military aide to Finland, was formerly a member of ex-Colonel OKUBO's special intelligence group. He is presently the temporary Chief of the Second Section Intelligence Squad, NSP.

Because of opposition from various areas at the time of its inception, CRC has not as yet been able to form anything of consequence. However, according to a recent report, the CGATA plan is well-established. It is being said that ex-generals SHINGURU, Sizama, ex-Major General YAMAGUCHI Yoshio, and YOSHIDA's advisor ex-Major General ATSUMI Eichi are secretly supporting IURAI Jun under the direction of CGATA. This is a fairly possible conjecture. This special intelligence group of ex-militarists bemoan the existing conditions by asserting that, "These private organizations being formed by the various official agencies are no more efficient than MITSUHASHI's private wireless station. It is very disheartening to feel that there may be countless others similar to MITSUHASHI's. We feel the need to dispense with the sectism practiced by the various ministries and to unite these activities on a national scale." However, we must realize that CGATA's suggestions cannot be accepted so readily. We must keep in step with the progress on the defense issue. We must expect public criticism on the handling of military and state secrets by the projected intelligence organ. No one can determine exactly what the future may bring.
