10. Haiti: The army is still unable to pin down the rebels who landed in Haiti last week and then took to the hills.

Duvalier, apparently in a continuing rage, is using the invasion as an excuse for more acts of repression. One example is the destruction of villages where the inhabitants are suspected of favoring the rebels.

The Dominicans, while denying any complicity in the landings, are keeping their armed forces on the alert. Duvalier has complained to the UN and the OAS and claims two Dominican frigates are cruising off Haiti's north coast.
