This responds to your 24 April 2000 memorandum, enclosed at Tab A, with which you sent us [redacted] documents [redacted] for our review and response to you. These documents surfaced as a result of Mark Zaid's 16 December 1999 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request regarding anthrax.

We offer no objection to declassification and release of [redacted] of the documents you sent us after certain CIA information is removed. Deletions have been made on the basis of FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). Copies of the redacted documents, bearing our processing numbers [redacted] are enclosed at Tab B.

We have determined that all of the information in [redacted] of the CIA reports must be denied in its entirety based on FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). Copies of the annotated documents, bearing our processing numbers [redacted] [redacted] are returned to you at Tab C.
