On 20 March 1959 Javier GUERRERO Saucedo and his wife, Clara Porset de GUERRERO, active Communists in Mexico, left Mexico City for Habana, Cuba, by air.

Comment. GUERRERO, a Mexican painter, is a member of the National Central Committee of the Partido Comunista Mexicano (PCM - Mexican Communist Party). His wife was born in Cuba. Both have been active in the Sociedad Mexicana de Amistad con China Popular (SMACP - Mexican Society of Friendship with the Chinese People's Republic) and the Movimiento Mexicano por la Paz (MMP - Mexican Peace Movement), which are Communist-front organizations.
