Confidential Informant T-1, of known reliability, advised on October 21, 1953, that he had learned, from a source which he considered reliable, that the subject was attending Catholic University through the

financial assistance of the newspaper "America". According to T-1 the subject was being assisted in this respect because of the good work he reportedly did while employed by that publication. T-1 further advised that the above publication is presently controlled by the finite of the formula of the Rumanian Orthodox Church. According to T-1 VIOREL RIFA was publicly known in Rumania as an officer of the Rumanian Iron Guard.

The records of the local Credit Bureau, 1221 C Street, N. W., contain a report dated April 17, 1953, indicating that STEFAN FICTOR POFESCU and his wife, MERSTIN H. POFESCU, reside in an apartment at 521 Meryland Avenue, N. B. This report further indicated that the subject and his wife formarly lived in Rome, Italy, and that the subject was a Graduate Student at Gatholic University. According to this report the subject's source of income was not learned; however, his wife was said to be employed since January 5, 1953, by the American Export Lines, Incorporated, Investment Building, Washington, D. C., as a Typist.
