Nicolae Carja, 4419 West 35th Street, New York City, USA  
advised a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation,  
on October 11, 1967, that a friend of his advised that Doctor  
Charles Kremer, was recently in Romania and while there, was  
contacted by the Romanian Intelligence Service.

Doctor Kremer was shown photographs of Viorel Trifa  
and instructed by the Romanian Intelligence Service to attack  
Trifa as a former fascist in order to destroy Trifa.

*Report of Dr. Charles Kremer's travel to Romania and contact with officials there regarding Viorel*

Carja advised that Kremer resides at the Westover Hotel,  
253 West 72nd Street, New York City, and is a dentist at 357 West  
37th Street, New York City. *TRIFA*

Carja described Trifa as Bishop of Romanian Orthodox  
Church of America and advised that he resides in Detroit,  
Michigan.

Carja refused to furnish any other details regarding  
what is mentioned above and refused to furnish name of individual  
who furnished him the information.
