During the wer, he was the most famous in the southern areas from Melay through Guadalcanal to Burma. It was not front line commanders but Staff Officer Tsuji who actually guided the operations of the Japanese army. In this sense, he ought to be the first to be resented by the war-bereaved families throughout the country.

Notwithstending this, it is alarming that he is now a favorite of journalism, writing semi-documentary war records one after another such as "12,000 Kilometers Underground" and "the Malay War", after he suddenly disappeared from the Japanese Army Headquarters at Bangkok on the very day of the termination of the war and dramatically re-appeared in Japan with the close of the investigation of Japanese war suspects by the former Allied Forces. He is a most surprising character though this is the age of "reverse course".

At present, however, he says that new Japan who renounced war should stay out of a third world war. From this stendpoint, he delivered a speech forecasting a Russo-American war at the Industry Club the other day, and in the speech he made a conclusion unfavorable to the U.S. Later the speech was exploited by leftwing elements for anti-US propaganda, but it is apparent that he is not a leftist.

Forty-eight years old, he is still a man of activity. With Japan's rearmament held imminent, there are found many pro-Tsuji persons among the old military starting various activities, especially among the young personnel of the National Police Reserve. Moreover, he is said to be connected with the old Enstern asia League established by the late Gen. Kanji Ishihara. The reaction of the league is being matched with keen interest. No one can say for sure that it will not re-kindle Maxism which may flare up among the people frustrated by the defeat and the Occupation and tired of lukewarm political parties. XH (100) 网络
