- Former Colonel TSUJI Masanobu (17/2398/0207) visited the Soviet Mission on 14 May 1952 to ask that a letter be delivered to his friend, former Colonel MISHIMA Takaji (Ryuji) (0005/0756/7127/2945), still being held as a war criminal by the USSR. Major General Aleksei P. Kislenko, then head of the mission, saw TSUJI alone, assured him that he personally would see ı. that the letter was delivered and invited him to visit the mission from time to time.
- With the money he has received from the sale of his many books, TSUJI has bought a large house in Marimune, Suginami-ku, Tokyo, and has made loans to finance the political activities of various organizations formed by members of the old East Asia League (Toa Remmei)(2639/0068/5114/4145), founded by ISHIHARA Kanji (4258/0626/1401/5112).
