- 2. Biographical information on ASARDA and TUUTI Musesobu is included in attachments; however, pertinent data more briefly presented is as follows:

THUI Passnobu is one of Jepan's leading ultranstismelists. A former amy colonel, he served in the Japanese Eventung amy and with the Japanese Emperial General Staff (JEGs) in Singapore, Chine, Summe and Theiland during the ver. After the surrander THUI went into biding to escape trial for war crimes, emerging only after termination of the trials in 1950. Since that time he has deveted himself to writing and to political intrigue. Several publications dealing with his escapedes brought him wide publicity as well as solid financial return emeling him to run successfully for the Lover House of the Japanese Diet in 1952. He was re-elected in 1953, TSUII heads several ultrunsticulaits organizations and in in contact with most importent rightist and militarist figures. He has been a vecal exponent of a neutralist, independent program for Japan, which has frequently been strongly enti-American in tone. For that reason and because he has been reported to have contested the Soviet Mingion on occasion, some doubts have been expressed concerning his layelty, Bet is generally considered, however, to be anti-Communist and extremely patriotic.

ASAEDA Shigsharu is a former Army Licentenant Colonel who served under TSGFI Messachu in the Eventung Army and with JIGS during the war,

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TSUJI Masanobu

10 December 1954

TSUJI Masanobu was a former colonel in the Japanese MWANGTUNG Army. When the Japanese army surrendered in August 1945, subject was in Burma, and was wanted by the British as a War Criminal. He escaped to Chungking from Burma and then went to Manking where he was employed by the Third (Intelligence) Section of the Chinese Defense Ministry, planning Chiang's campaigns and writing tactical manuals lased on his own experiences. At this tipe he was in contact with General OKAMURA Neiji; (Gen DOI and Major-General IS'AO Shib-cheng (Chief of first section of the Chinese Mission). Subject returned to Japan in disguise in early 1948 and since that time has been going from place to place in an attempt to frustrate the investigations of various agencies which are attempting to locate him. TSUJI claimed that he has not left Japan since his initial return in 1948. He discussed briefly the rash of sensational articles in various journals which described him as being disguised as a priest and a cting as a courier for the Chinese. TSUJI dismissed such stories as blatant falsehoods and claimed that he has merely attempted to evade capture as a war criminal and has not engaged in any nefarious activities. He stated that he had "taken over the position of Gen ISHIMAR Kanji, who died in 1949, in the East Asia League (TOA RENMEI). (Source a meeting between subj and CD agent 6 March 1950)

The British terminated their war crimes trials on 30 Sept 1949 and stated TSUJI Masanobu was no longer wanted by them. When subject heard this, he came out of hiding, and returned to his home. Some sources claimed that Chinese intelligence-collecting in Janan was directed from Manking under TSUJI's guidance.

In 1949 subject reportedly recruited Japanese mercenaries for Chinese Mationalist tray; also travelled back and forth between Japanese connected with recruitment program. He visited MODAMA Yoshio, former Shanghai, intelligence agent, and KAGAWA Yoshio, former intelligence agent.

In July 51 subject spoke at the Fivnjin (Liberalists) club, Tokyo and stated chances are dim for the USA to win WVIII against Russia. He admitted all the

In July 51 subject spoke at the living (Liberalists) club, Tokyo and stated chances are dim for the USA to win WIII against Russia. He admitted all the statistics he compiled to make the above statement took him one and a half years of painstaking scrutiny of the intelli once before reaching his conclusion. (The above speech was used by the JUP for propaganda purposes.) Subject was indicated by the Atty-General's office for violating Purge ordinance by making the above mentioned speech.

Early in 1951 subject attended several meetings of nationalist groups in Takamatsu city and Kita-gun, Kagawa Prefecture. He reportedly held secret conferences with KIHURA Kakuro, former councillor of the last Asia League for the purpose of discussing reconstruction of the League in view of the approaching depurge of the League members. They allegedly are making plans for the unification of all Right-wing organisations to be affected immediately following the signing of the Peace treaty.

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On 13 July 1951 SUBJECT while visiting in Magano, agreed to help

The Patriotic Faith Society follows a policy of maintaining strict secrecy; a proposal was made that the Society gather info about the Simissing Communist leaders and supply the police with this information for as to alleviate the attention of the police toward the Society, Because most of the members of the Society are former military officers their info collecting activity is centered on tactical forecasts of the 3rd WW. Accordingly, special info collectors are provided in the lower schelons, and a great affort is being made to ascertain the movements of the Communists, both in Japan and abroad. It is reported that 27 members of the Society have secretly made their way to Red China and the Soviet Union in order to ascertain the actual conditions in those places. The fact that ax-Maj-Geny WAKURO is an officer in this Society indicates that the intalligence collection system of the former MAKANO group (Jap military Police who were trained at a school in Makano Ward) has been admosted.

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Among the persons whom TSUJI seeks persons by are former Lt\_Colonel\_ASAEDA.

a former staff officer of the Kyantung Army and areput from Siberia; and SUE, T'se, said to be a member of the Chinese Communist intelligence organization; and others who are said to be secret Communists. It is believed that TSUJI's reason for contacting such persons may be to exchange intelligence.

It was reported that one of "TSUJI's SPES" was apprehended within the Tokyo Metropolitan committee of the JUP on 25 July 1951. This person freely confessed and even stated that he had been meeting TSUJI or an accomplice in the vicinity of Shibuya station on the 2, 12th and 22 of each mouth. The JUI is going to use this person as a double agent. (ctd 13 Sept 51. Eval 8-2)

KITAHARA Genichiro, a former member of last Asia League is reported to have made the following statement in substance, to an unidentified friends—"I met TSUJI in Lanking China while I was stationed there as an interpreter with the Japanese China Dispatch Army; I worked with him for about a year, I learned through TSUJI of the Power of a Chinase secret organization called THUMANDONO (phonetic) led by ATU, Tueb-shang, and dedicated to the principle of Precial defense."

TSUMI is not a Communist, on the contrary, his background is military and ultramationalistic. An army colonel, he was a number of the clique of Lt-Gan ISHIHARA Kanji and of ISHIHARA's nationalistic East Asia League which was banned in 1946. During his army days he worked in intelligence and in strategic planning; he had prestige beyond his rank, presumably due to his connections with higher ranking militarists and because he was at one time an aide to the Emperor's younger brother, Prince Himan. His present position is anti-US and anti-USSR favoring a "third force". (apr 52)

Subject was elected to the House of Representatives in Oct 52, as an Independent. He is a Director of Japan-China Trade Promotion Assn as of June 53.

A former Class "A" War Crimes suspect, MCDAMA Yoshio, former head of "MCDAMA KIKAN", a group of agents serving under the "appeace Many in Shanghai, is known to be one of SASAGWA's co-workers. It is regard that MCDAMA has been taking part in a so-called "Troop organising plan" which is secretly working with the CCP. MCDAMA appears to be keening contest with TSUJI, Masanobu, organiser of the ultra nationalist Patriotism and Devotion Society (June 51).

CIE report dated 10 March 1950 Investigation Report by Maj RIMALDUCCI.

"This report traces subject's background and activities and adds info concerning attempts made by US Air force Hqs to utilize TSUJI. This report states that EDDAMA Yoshio, released war criminal suspect, recommended TSUJI to Col Frank of USAF as "the individual who could represent the best among former Japanese officers". EDDAMA is said to have know TSUJI years ago in anking. The report states that TSUJI declined to meet Col Frank for the reason that if he were to ecoperate with the American Army, he wented to do so through MEAKI Sadao, under life sentence in Sugama Prison. The report also sentions the Air Forces unsuccessful attempts to obtain the book written by TSUJI covering his secret

SUBJECT has currently been conferring with an undisclosed masser of former officers in preparation for the formation of an organization made up of exservicemen. These men have expressed a strong interest in the future of Japan and have indicated that former military men with strong nationalistic spirit, should band together and assist in formulating the future of Japan. Subject has revealed his opposition to the acceptance of MSA aid and has urged Japan as to exerts an army of its own. They plan to inaugurate an organization during the Spring of 1954.
