REPORT ON TSUJI--The North Vietnam Red Cross has termed groundless a report that Masanobu Tsuji, member of the Upper House, came to Hanoi from Laos, according to information received 30 June by the Japan Red Cross. The information from the North Vietnam Red Cross was in reply to a JRC inquiry 9 May for the whereabouts of Tsuji, who has been missing since April last year when he left Japan for southeast Asia ostensibly on an inspection trip. Information received here earlier had indicated that Tsuji, noted strategist of the defunct Japanese Army, had left Kheng Khay for Hanoi aboard a Soviet plane.
