A. COUNTER-ESPIONAGE.

1. Soviet IS:

6: dropped.

9: (*) CW H has not yet reported whether nor how the case could be continued; rather CW H has reported that the case would be dropped and that details would be forthcoming; SRIS reaction can not yet be predicted.

11: V-928.4 married the mother of V-928.6. It appears that the SRIS still wants to catch V-928.4, but that the latter is in no immediate danger. Nevertheless, plans and preparations have been made for emergency evacuation of V-928.4 to western Germany, should this become necessary--see memo 5611, in case report.

13: In May '53 V-2948 kept his appointed BW in Berlin with his SRIS case officer, from whom he received further RILs, the nature of which *leads* Zipper to believe that the SRIS office may belong to the GRU. [] inclines to the opposite conclusion, i.e. that it is more likely to be the MVD (ex-KGB) than the GRU. In view of difficulties encountered in obtaining clearance to pass build-up material from the British Zone, "KUTZBACH" (L0/P-2) has suggested that CV L consider moving "HISSEL" to the US zone of Germany. Zipper has invited the British liaison officer [] to come to Zipper

111: (*) Establishment of contact between V-4168 and MEUNIER planned for May '53 did not take place because of failure on the part of the EFV to arrange the contact, as agreed. Indications from GV G are that this case is about to be dropped.

2. East German IS:

112 (RINGELSPIEL, SILBERSTREIFEN, STERN). "RINGEL" was approached by travelling agents (DRECHSLER) of the NDFD; OSTERWALDT has left the NDFD for west Germany but whether as agent or refugee is still not clear. In SILBERSTREIFEN the dropping out of intermediary Frau KLATTE-COLONNA posed a problem, though the source is attempting to establish direct contact with her superior, LEHNHANS-LITZMANN and is trying to disassociate himself from her. Re the STERN case, GV L's branch of this NDFD complex, see attachment.

113: The eastern office behind this appears to be MSS, Chemnitz, rather than Dresden; the case has not yet been reported by Zipper.

114: Still in initial stage; no new information.

115: Penetration of MSS, Suhl. See attachment.

4. Hungarian IS:

300: 15 memos submitted by Zipper, last # 5715. UM has finally been persuaded to plan and prepare for communications arrangements in the event ADLER were eventually recalled to Hungary.

302: 11 memos submitted by Zipper. The EASTPOL has been pressing GELER to set a firm date for his leave, to be spent in Hungary; as yet it has not been possible to persuade GELER to take this trip to Hungary; the case officer is continuing his attempts to build up GELER psychologically to undertake this trip.

382: "Dropped" by Zipper. We consider the case "on ice", pending YIS reaction to attempted drop. YIS might refuse to accept source's unilateral resignation.
