A. CONFIDENTIAL-SOURCES.

1. Soviet IS:

# 9: (\*). Although the dropping report from CV II has not yet been received, V-500h has been dropped. Although Zipper has no further plans for contact, the possibility that the SRIS might seek to reestablish contact with V-500h has been borne in mind. For this reason a channel has been left open for V-500h to report any such move by the SRIS.

# 11: No new information has been obtained. Zipper favors the transfer of V-928.h to West Germany.

# 13: In this case Zipper has, in a rare instance, taken the initiative and moved a double agent from one geographical area to another. V-294h has been moved from Hamburg to the Heidelberg area where he will represent the south German interest of his firm as a salesman. Unfortunately, V-294h, through youthful indiscretion, has exposed his IS activities to some extent to his mother and his girl friend by informing them that he is also active for an anti-communist office in West Germany. # 14: (\*). The BFV has now announced that the leader of the LfV in Mainz is awaiting V-4168 in order to place him in contact with HANSLER. However, in the meantime OV G has expressed serious objections to taking up this case and the Zipper headquarters OE staff has requested WELLMY's approval to turn down the opportunity of taking up this case as offered by the French IS.

2. East German IS:

#112: a. RINGELSPIEL: Two further reports received during June were reported to us in memo 6008. Travelling agents of the NDFD established contact with RINGEL, one of whose assistance was also brought into this case. Further information on support points of the (west side) of the NDFD in Schleswig-Holstein and the establishment of a new veterans organization as well as on meetings of NJ veterans in Hendsburg was obtained.

b. SILBERSTRIPSEN: Two more reports were obtained in June submitted as memo 5810. Source sent information on Frau KLATTE-KOLEHNA.

c. STERN: Five further reports were submitted as Zipper memos 5795 and 5837. "WASSERMANN" sent an NDF program to SEELISCH, business manager of the NDFD. Pending a reply from the latter, "WASSERMANN" has been put to work on the NDF in Hesse as the sister organization of the East Zone NDFD.

#113: The meeting with the NDF case officer took place in Berlin as planned. Nothing unusual developed. A comprehensive Zipper report on this case should be forthcoming in the near future now that "BAYERLE" has returned from leave. Zipper considers the case interesting and valuable, especially because of the possibility of contracting it with Case #116.

#114: No reports have been received by Zipper headquarters which has requested a report of developments from its field agency. This will be forwarded when received.

#115: Penetration source submitted 15 reports which were forwarded by Zipper headquarters as memos 5891 and 5947. Reporting is definitely improved and the results of better and tighter leadership are expected to produce even more valuable reports from this penetration source.

#116: Six reports so far pertain to build-up material. The last RV took place on 15 and 16 June in Magdeburg, report on which is pending.

3. Czech IS:

#230: Case is developing as planned. Zipper submitted as reports memos 5850, 5898 and 5900. Despite the confused political situation in Berlin during this month, V-2653.10 planned to keep his RV in Berlin on 26 June.

#231: "BOHEMIA" - a new case run by CV L on which the first report has not yet been received.

4. Hungarian IS:

#300: 17 memos, the last of them No. 6007, were submitted. According to these, the arrival of a KATPOL courier was expected during this period. U/M made various plans for maintaining communications with ADLER when and if the latter should return to Hungary.

#302: GEIER reported a number of instances of difficulty in receiving his KATPOL W/F communications. KATPOL is insisting that GEIER utilize his leave to come to Budapest. The latter, however, is still determined not to go to Hungary. In order to keep the play going, GEIER has reported preparations as though he were going to use his leave to go to Hungary. At the last moment it is planned that GEIER will announce that it has come to the attention of American authorities that he has applied for a visa to

go to Vienna and that because of his employment in an American office, American security authorities will not grant permission for travel behind the Iron Curtain. Inasmuch as it has not been possible to persuade GREER to return for a short trip to Hungary, we very seriously question the future value of this case and have requested a thorough discussion with Zipper headquarters and field agency case officer with regard to the possibility of having to terminate the case in the near future and of the various possibilities of exploiting the case during this period under these conditions.

#350: No reports and no Polish IS contact occurred during the month. Attempts to utilize contacts within the BLANK office are still in progress.

8. Illegal Activities Communist Party,  
Germany:

#505-A: Provided one report on the GEF suitable for dissemination to general security offices. Further conduct of this case as such depends on the development of UJ-DROLLERY #706.

#506: Dropped. Transferred to BfV.

9. Communist Mass Organizations:

#706: No reports were received by Zipper headquarters which has requested CV B to submit status and progress reports.

10. Illegal East-West Trade:

#1003: Source continues to report considerable and valuable information, according to Zipper, which forwarded memos 5933-5938 and 5942. Most of the reports are sent to Zipper's positive economic section for utilization.

11. Political Intelligence:

#1201: Source submitted 19 reports which were disseminated in one memo and two EGLs. Source's reporting was disseminated because of the situation in Berlin and the sensitive position occupied by source.

#1202: During the month of June two reports were received on the organization of the ADN which will be incorporated in the forthcoming study of the ADN.

#1212: Dropped.

#1213: Dropped.

#1214: Source submitted 18 reports from which Zipper disseminated one memo and seven EGLs after return of source from leave on 9 June. The content of the reports was considerably better though, unfortunately, source had not yet been able to report on the Berlin situation.

#1215: Dropped.

#1216: During this period both source and sub-source were on leave and only three reports were received, forwarded as one EGL.

#1217: Source submitted four reports of which three have not yet been evaluated and one of which will be used for the combined study on the MDPD. Despite the withdrawal from commitment of the actual sub-source on which this case was originally based, several other active possibilities are foreseen by Zipper which is continuing to consider this case as active.

#1218: Unsatisfactory development. Only one report on a possible informant of no significance.
