1. The attachments to reference and to the earlier progress reports have in most instances been incorporated into the appropriate UJ DROLLERY dossier, since frequently they represent the most recent information available here on the case in question. These summaries are of value mainly because they provide us with an otherwise unavailable account of the current progress (or lack of same) of a particular case, and at the same time give us at least an inkling of what various Zipperites are doing to develop new cases. It is hoped, however, that these summaries will not supplant the detailed case reporting, which, of course, is of far greater value to all concerned. If regular progress reports on each of the active UJ DROLLERY cases could be submitted on at least a monthly basis, these general summaries could be eliminated or limited to a preliminary reporting of new cases.

2. In reviewing these progress reports, we came across the following points which are not quite clear. We would appreciate receiving whatever additional data FOB may be able to obtain on these items.

a. UJ DROLLERY 112 (SILBERSTREIFEN and STERN) - In view of the information contained in paragraph 9a, page 12 of EGLA-2771, we thought that the source of SILBERSTREIFEN might be identity 2 of EGLA-2772. However, the description of the source of this case, as given in the attachment to EGLA-3577, does not seem to correspond with what is known about "PREUSSEN". Is there any chance of finding out who the source of SILBERSTREIFEN is, and whether or not "PREUSSEN" is still involved in any part of the UJ DROLLERY 112 complex? Are any of the remaining identities listed in EGLA-2772 identical with STERN?

b. UJ DROLLERY 506 - Since V-13940.1 has been dropped by Zipper, would it be possible to ascertain his true name? The little data which we have on this person would be of far greater value for future reference if we knew who he was.

c. UJ DROLLERY 1003 - V-3080.8 has apparently been an active Zipper source for some time. Is his true name and/or any additional operational data available?

d. UJ DROLLERY 1213 - EGLA-3577 states that the source of UJ DROLLERY 1213 was described as a Communist agent in UJ DROLLERY 1209. Our file on UJ DROLLERY 1209 consists only of WGLA-8658 and the attachment to WGLA-9115. Is MEIFORTH (attachment to WGLA-8658) identical with the source of UJ DROLLERY 1213? Have there been further developments in UJ DROLLERY 1209 since November 1951? Since the target of UJ DROLLERY 1213 is Communist activities, it would not seem unusual for a source reporting on this target to be described by an outsider as a Communist agent. Further clarification of this matter, including the reason the source was dropped, and his true name, would be most useful. We presume he was not dropped for being described as a Communist agent. According to EGLA-1564, this source would seem to be of some value in the UJ DROLLERY 112 complex.

e. UJ DROLLERY 1216 - EGLA-3577 reports that Zipper's agent in touch with the source of UJ DROLLERY 1216 has been threatened by a flap involving other Zipper agents. We have no other information on this flap, and we would appreciate receiving pertinent details, when available. Was the security of "QUAND" also threatened?

f. UJ DROLLERY 1217 - We could not readily locate a copy of Der Spiegel containing the article mentioned in EGLA-3870. It would be appreciated if FBI could send us a copy. Is V-5744 identical with the subject of this article?
