

2. POB had the following comments regarding the attachment to reference:
- a. Re Paragraph 1
We know of no ZIPPER report to us to that effect. [] reported that both ZIPPER's @ Dr. ALBERTI and @ HERRMANN have stated to him that they expected such a move.
 - b. Re Paragraph 2
These telephone numbers have recurred in UJ-DROLLERY # 15 after appearing first in the HOEHER case (Hqs. File No. [] , UJ-DROLLERY # 11; Operation WELLE (EGLA-10466), and in the case reported in EGLA-4058. According to [] the last sentence of paragraph 2 represents the ZIPPER Hqs. case officer's (@ KUTZBACH's) evaluation of UJ-DROLLERY # 15.
 - c. Re Paragraph 3
We believe that the information about the St. Antonius hospital was largely acquired from "KUERASSIER" (see EGLA-13809). Information on other buildings inside the Karlshorst Compound is believed to be the product of UJ-DROLLERY # 112-D and of "KUERASSIER." A specific run-down on reports dealing with these buildings was promised [] by ZIPPER's @ HERRMANN several months ago, but has not been received.
 - d. Re Paragraph 5
Sub-paragraph 2 of this paragraph is believed to be based on interrogations of technicians returned from the Soviet Union, while sub-paragraph 3 is considered to represent information which we had passed to ZIPPER in the form of a sanitized version of EGQW-21894.
 - e. Re Paragraph 6
This instance is believed to have been based on the case of an unidentified secretary or typist working for a West German Government office in Bonn (possibly the Foreign Office). According to ZIPPER, she was approached by the SRIS while visiting her parents in the Soviet Zone. Upon her return, she immediately reported this approach, but refused to become involved in any double-play. In connection with this story, ZIPPER mentioned the alleged incompetence of the security officer of the Foreign Office in Bonn whom they claimed had fumbled several leads.
 - f. Re Paragraph 9
We have not yet seen any ZIPPER reports on this.
 - g. Re the "Beurteilung"
[] reports the statements contained in paragraph 1 of the "Beurteilung" to be those of @ Dr

ALBERTI who disagrees with the MVD/KGB breakdown as given by [] expects this to cause some confusion since other ZIPPER staffers such as @ HERRMANN are obliged to accept @ Dr. ALBERTI's views.

h. Re Paragraph 16

[] comments that the EEI referred to in this paragraph is from UJ-DROLLERY # 120.

i. Re Paragraph 19

[] Comment: The use of West German KP functionaries by Eastern Intelligence Services was reported on in EGLA-13147 and is, of course, of interest to USAREUR, who commented that they have received sufficient reports to indicate an increase of this type of activity. ZIPPER's source of this report is in the Bavarian Border Police.

k. Re Anlage 2

References for this SRIS deception effort are EGLA-12470, EGLA-10630 and others.

l. Re Anlage 3

Paragraph 1 is possibly based on UJ-DROLLERY # 112-D and on UJ DROLLERY # 1201. However, in # 1201, "ERFINDER" was not asked, as far as we know, to invite West German members of parliament.

m. Re Paragraph 4

The second SRIS mission listed here was given to the agents in UJ-DROLLERY's # 15 and # 1201.

n. Re Paragraph 5

For the SRIS mission listed in fourth place, see EGLA-13627; re the fifth, see PULL-9632, BRLN-7385, MUNI-9032, etc.

o. Re Paragraph 6

The SRIS mission listed in fifth place is believed to have appeared in ZIPPER's Fall SCHAPER (see EGLA-14519), while the one listed in ninth place appeared in UJ-DROLLERY # 15.

p. Re Paragraph 7

The one SRIS mission listed here is believed to have been taken from UJ-DROLLERY # 15.
