Other pertinent data: "The basic reason for dropping this case is that BURSCHENSCHAFT was known to V-2600 (ALBERT) by his true name and true address. It is therefore, most probable that the SFS and/or the SdB were informed that the agent was under ZIPPER control. ZIPPER discovered in investigating the ALBERT flap that the case was probably known to the East as early as June 1954. BURSCHENSCHAFT has been instructed not to return to the East." (EGLA-16380)
