Other pertinent data: MORCHE and his fiancée were captured by the Czechs near the border in April 1953 and released after MORCHE agreed to work for the STB. Upon return he reported the incident and was interrogated by the CIC. CIC apparently did not desire to use MORCHE so he was recruited by UPSWING. A mail intercept by CIC contained ~~sp~~material re CIC installation passed without their approval, so they said. Small flap resulted. Case was never developed into anything significant and shortly after flap was discontinued.
