1. In response to reference a,   Base will now forward to Headquarters all CASCOPE reporting on Yugoslav and other Soviet bloc targets (excluding East Germany). This will include reports on political and economic as well as military subjects.

2. The economic and political reports concerned will present no problem, since normally they are practically never disseminated outside of INTRUST. The military reports are somewhat different, since they are normally disseminated to USAFI and USAREUR. The criteria of not giving field dissemination to any report suspected of emanating from an in-place asset will practically stop this field dissemination and will soon be reflected in the statistics which are so meticulously kept by USAFI and USAREUR. In order to forestall any complaints to CASCOPE by USAFI and USAREUR, we will explain to them that some of this type of reporting has become suspect and that we are temporarily withholding dissemination of it. In some cases, as explained in paragraph 4, it may be necessary to make limited field dissemination.

3. The developments described in reference b may well bring this problem to a head sooner than was expected.

4. Attached for Headquarters only are copies of all CASCOPE reports on Soviet bloc targets (excluding East Germany) received between 5 and 19 June 1972. They are as follows:
