The most extreme rightist organizations seem to be located in this town and the organization is well fortified. Josef Vasvary is a former major general who commanded during the war the 5th Division of the First Hungarian Army. His entire professional military service was in the staff and command branch. His real name is not Vasvary, but Eisinzer. He is a smart man who speaks many languages well. Prior to 1940 he was the Hungarian Military Attache in Belgrade. He is about 50 or 55, a representative type man who is definitely oriented toward the French forces and cooperates with them completely. His is the only constructive group and not in good terms with the Teleky group.
