SPECIFIC: Dr. Wilhelm Voss

The following report (MEM-202), dated 28 April 1955, is forwarded for your information:

1. On 28 February 1955 Dr. Wilhelm Voss' contract was renewed for one year with no changes in salary and allowances. However, he will no longer be an advisor to the Ministry of War, but, with his consent, has been assigned as personal advisor to the Minister of Commerce and Industry.

2. Apparently Dr. Voss intends to spend his leave permanently as he and his children are making a serious study of Arabic and he is gradually bringing all his personal affairs to a close here.

3. Dr. Voss has stated that he intends to establish an independent office in Cairo which would employ a number of Egyptian engineers and technicians for all the important post-war work in German Egypt. Dr. Voss also plans to request Minister [Redacted] for permission for the German advisors employed by the Ministry of War to assist him in his office.
