November 140-August 142: Lt. Commander Naval Attache (Intelligence) in Mexico. Present raik: Captain. 2/

War Time: A report with excerpts from "The Black Chamber" (Stealing of code books from U.S. Consulate) states the following: "TAKAGI (TASHIRO Hideya in the story) and Lt. Commander WACHI (WASHI in the story) tried night and day to break the new code that the US Embossy had started to use. They even arranged through trashmen to collect all waste that came out of the Embassy, in the hope of finding some clue to the code in scraps of paper thrown into the waste baskets." 1/

Postwar: In WACHI's post-war Buddhist incarnation, he became an "executive priest" in the BYAKUREN SHA (White Lotus Society), which has its Headquarters in the Tsukiji Honganji, Tokyo-to, Chuo-ku, Tsukiji, 3-chore, and is headed by one ONISHI Kazumasa. 1/

1952: As an "executive priest" in the BYAKUREN SHA, Subject made a highly publicized trip to Iwo Jima in January-March 1952 to collect the ashes of his former subordinates. On his return he was summoned to the Tokyo District Procurators' Office in connection with charges that the White L tus Society had received second hand clothing from Buddhists in the U.S. to be distributed free to the meedy and had instead sold them to dealers and then distributed the profits among the officials of the Society. (The outcome of the case is unknown.) 1/

1953: In a summary translation of an article which appeared in the 31 March 1953 edition of the <u>Asahi Shimbun</u>, it was noted that one of the characteristics of the <u>election campaign</u> at that time was the marked increase in number of former military men and rightists who were candidates openly advocating rearmament. WACHI Tsunezo (Progressive) was a candidate for the House of Councillors running as an Independent. Subject was backed by or sought the support of the KAIKO KAI and SUIKO KAI, re-established associations of alumni of the Military and Naval Academies; the Federation for the Re-establishment of Hilitary Pensions and Systems (GUNJIN ONKYU FUKKATSU KISEI DOMEI); and the Federation of Families of the War Dead (I KAZOKU REMEI). 3/

A report dated 7 July 1955 states that Subject was once suspected of using the IWO JIMA ASSOCIATION for spying. b/
