CURRENT ILLNESS:

AT AGE 69, WITH SOMEWHAT LIMITED REPORTING, THERE ARE NO KNOWN SIGNIFICANT MEDICAL PROBLEMS WHICH SHOULD LIMIT HIS CAPACITY TO GOVERN. HE HAS APPEARED TO BE UNDER STRESS AS THE REACTION TO HIS ALLEGED INVOLVEMENT IN WAR CRIMES WAXES AND WANES.

MEDICAL HISTORY:

THERE ARE REPORTS OF A HEART CONDITION IN THE 1960'S AND EARLY 70'S BUT THERE ARE NO RECENT REPORTS INDICATING THIS IS A PROBLEM. IN 1982 HE WAS STRUCK BY A STREETCAR, THROWN SEVERAL FEET AND MADE AN UNEVENTFUL RECOVERY.

PROGNOSIS:

HIS ACTIVITY LEVEL IN RECENT YEARS TEND TO INDICATE THAT IF HE HAS A CARDIAC PROBLEM (FROM 1970), IT IS NOT LIMITING. HE IS AN INTENSE INDIVIDUAL AND HAS HAD EMOTIONAL REACTION TO CRITICISM. WHILE THERE IS NO REASON TO SUSPECT A SIGNIFICANT ADVERSE HEALTH EVENT, HE DOES HAVE SIGNIFICANT RISK FACTORS.
