

- I. POLITICAL CORRESPONDENTS REPORTED THAT IN A BRIEFING YESTERDAY TO THE KNESSET DEFENSE AND FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE, PM PERES DOWNPLAYED THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE SUMMIT. HE EXPLAINED THAT ASSAD WAS TOO BUSY RIGHT NOW KEEPING HIS CHAOTIC ECONOMY ABOVE WATER, HIS INTERNAL ENEMIES IN CHECK AND THE SITUATION IN LEBANON FROM GETTING OUT OF HAND TO BE ABLE TO TAKE TIME OFF FOR OTHER ISSUES.
