YEDIOT ALSO REPORTED THAT "JERUSALEM WAS VERY PLEASED WITH THE SUMMIT'S DECLARATION, STRESSING THAT IT REINFORCES ISRAEL'S LONG-STANDING POLICY THAT TERROR SHOULD BE FOUGHT IN EVERY POSSIBLE WAY."

III. JERUSALEM POST WROTE IN A FRONTPAGE STORY:
"ALTHOUGH THE SUMMIT DECLARATION DIDN'T ENDORSE THE USE
OF FORCE OR NEW ECONOMIC SANCTIONS, U.S. OFFICIALS WERE
EXULTANT OVER THE COMMON STAND AGAINST TERRORISM.
SECRETARY OF STATE SHULTZ SAID IT WAS 'WONDERFUL' AND
CALLED IT 'A LONG AND VERY GOOD DAY FOR DEMOCRACY'
ALSO YESTERDAY, THE TOKYO SUMMIT CALLED ON THE SOVIET
UNION TO 'URGENTLY' PROVIDE INFORMATION ON ITS APRIL 26
NUCLEAR ACCIDENT AND TO JOIN IN INTERNATIONAL TALKS TO
