1. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, CHANCELLOR FRED SINOWATZ WILL PAY AN OFFICIAL VISIT TO THE U.S. JUNE 23-26. SINOWATZ, WHO WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY FM LEOPOLD GRATZ, WILL MEET WITH PRESIDENT REAGAN JUNE 24. (SEMI-OFFICIAL WIENER ZEITUNG, SOCIALIST AZ, INDEPENDENT KURIER, MAY 14)

GRATZ HOLDS TALKS WITH SWEDISH FM IN STOCKHOLM

2. AUSTRIAN FM GRATZ, WHO BEGAN AN OFFICIAL 2-DAY VISIT TO SWEDEN MAY 13, MET WITH HIS SWEDISH COUNTERPART FOR TALKS ON EAST-WEST RELATIONS, THE CHERNOBYL NUCLEAR DISASTER AND THE VIENNA CSCE FOLLOW-UP CONFERENCE LATER THIS YEAR. GRATZ UNDERLINED AUSTRIA'S DETERMINATION TO PRESENT INITATIVES FOR INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS ON SECURITY AND SUPERVISION OF NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS TO THE IAEA. REFERRING TO DISARMAMENT QUESTIONS, GRATZ SAID EUROPE-BASED TACTICAL NUCLEAR WEAPONS CONSTITUTE A HIGH RISK. THE CHERNOBYL SHOCK SHOULD BE USED TO LAUNCH NEW INITIATIVES TO ELIMINATE SUCH WEAPONS. 4. IN VARIOUS STATEMENTS IN VIENNA MAY 12 AND 13, VISITING SOUTH AFRICAN BISHOP TUTU REPEATED HIS CONDEMNATION OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN APARTHEID SYSTEM. ACCORDING TO TUTU, THE SITUATION MIGHT EVENTUALLY NECESSITATE UN INTERVENTION TO BRING ABOUT DEMOCRATIC CHANGES. HE UNDERLINED HIS DEMANDS THAT THE WHITE REGIME GRANT AMNESTY TO ALL POLITICAL PRISONERS AND ORGANIZATIONS. THE BLACK CHURCHMAN ALSO CRITICIZED THE WEST FOR ITS HESITANT IMPLEMENTATION OF SANCTIONS AGAINST SOUTH AFRICA. IN THE CASE OF POLAND, NICARAGUA AND LIBYA THE WEST HAS USED A MUCH MORE DETERMINED APPROACH. TUTU THANKED THE AUSTRIAN PEOPLE FOR THEIR MORAL SUPPORT OF THE ANTI-APARTHEID MOVEMENT.
