MANY THINK THAT EVEN IF HE HASN'T BEEN PROVEN A WAR CRIMINAL, AUSTRIA SHOULDN'T HAVE STAINED ITS IMAGE BY MAKING HIM PRESIDENT. THIS, HOWEVER, DOESN'T MEAN THAT WASHINGTON, LONDON, PARIS AND OTHER WESTERN CAPITALS WILL OSTRACIZE A COUNTRY WHICH IS A PART OF THE VERY SMALL CLUB OF FREE DEMOCRATIC STATES.
