- -- MAARIV AND HA'ARETZ REPORTED THAT STATE DEPARTMENT LEGAL ADVISER SOFAER YESTERDAY SUGGESTED THAT AN AMERICAN-ISRAELI-EGYPTIAN TEAM JOINTLY CONDUCT A SURVEY OF THE AREA AND SUBMIT ITS FINDINGS TO THE ARBITRATORS. -- THE JERUSALEM POST CITED PM PERES AS SAYING THAT "I HAVE RECEIVED MESSAGES FROM PRESIDENT MUBARAK THAT A NEW CHAPTER IN ISRAELI-EGYPTIAN RELATIONS WILL OPEN AFTER THE COMPROMIS HAS BEEN SIGNED".

DUE TO THE GEOGRAPHICAL CLOSENESS TO ISRAEL, IT ENABLED ARAFAT TO ESTABLISH CONTACT WITH THE PALESTINIAN POPULATION IN THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES AND RENEW HIS TERRORIST ACTIVITY HERE. HIS EXPULSION FROM JORDAN WILL MAKE IT VERY DIFFICULT FOR HIM TO MAINTAIN THIS".

- II. MA'ARIV CORRESPONDENTS SHEFI GABAI AND AVINOAM BAR-YOSEF REPORTED THAT "ISRAEL WILL IN THE VERY NEAR FUTURE HARDEN ITS ATTITUDE TO THE PRO-PLO POPULATION IN THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES, IN ORDER TO STRENGTHEN JORDAN'S SUPPORTERS AND INCREASE KING HUSSEIN'S INFLUENCE THERE SECURITY SOURCES YESTERDAY SAID THAT (JORDANIAN MEASURES TO BOOST ITS POSITION IN THE WEST BANK) WERE IN LINE WITH ISRAELI AND U.S. INTERESTS IN COMBATTING TERRORISM AND INCREASING THE INFLUENCE OF MODERATE PALESTINIAN ELEMENTS THE SHUTTING DOWN OF THE PLO OFFICES SHOCKED THE TERRITORIES' RESIDENTS, CONFUSED HUSSEIN'S SUPPORTERS AND GENERATED EXPRESSIONS OF FURY ON THE PART OF PLO SUPPORTERS. EAST JERUSALEM PALESTINIAN SOURCES YESTERDAY EXPRESSED THEIR CONCERN THAT THE RIFT BETWEEN HUSSEIN AND ARAFAT WOULD LEAD TO VIOLENT CLASHES IN THE WEST BANK AND THE GAZA STRIP, WHICH MIGHT DEVELOP INTO A BLOODBATH." - I. MAARIV EDITORIAL SAID: "A HUNDRED YEARS HAVE PASSED SINCE THE STATUE OF LIBERTY ARRIVED AT THE SHORES OF NEW YORK. THE STATUE ITSELF, WHICH BECAME A VISUAL SYNONYM FOR THE GREATEST DEMOCRACY IN THE WORLD, MIGHT HAVE GROWN OLD, BUT THE PRINCIPLES FOR WHICH IT STANDS HAVE NOT. POLITICAL, GENERAL AND INDIVIDUAL FREEDOM IS STILL HALLOWED AND FOUGHT FOR BY MILLIONS ALL OVER THE WORLD EVEN THOUGH THE COMMITMENT ENFOLDED IN THE LINES OF JEWISH-AMERICAN POET EMMA LAZARUS, INVITING THE REFUGEES OF THE 'OLD WORLD' TO THE 'NEW WORLD', HAS NOT ALWAYS BEEN FULFILLED, THE PASSION FOR FREEDOM REMAINS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE LEGACY OF THE JEWISH AND AMERICAN PEOPLES."
- II. HA'ARETZ COLUMNIST YOAV KARNI WROTE FROM NEW YORK JULY 4: "THE FRIENDS OF THE U.S. HAVE A UNIQUE PRIVILEGE: THEY ARE ALLOWED TO HATE IT. DESPITE THEIR HATRED, THE U.S. WILL GO ON DOING ALL IT CAN TO HELP THEM IN A CERTAIN CULTURAL AND POLITICAL CLIMATE,

3. KURT WALDHEIM'S INAUGURATION:

I. ALL MEDIA REPORTED THAT ISRAEL AND THE U.S. WILL STAY AWAY FROM TODAY'S SWEARING-IN CEREMONY. ISRAEL IS SAID TO HAVE DECIDED TO DOWNGRADE ITS DIPLOMATIC REPRESENTATION IN VIENNA IN PROTEST AGAINST WALDHEIM'S ELECTION. IN THE KNESSET TODAY, THE FILM HOLOCAUST WILL BE SHOWN AT THE TIME OF THE INAUGURATION CEREMONY. II. MAARIV EDITORIAL WROTE: "NO HONORABLE MAN CAN COMPLIMENT AUSTRIA FOR ITS DECISION. ONE COULD ONLY FEEL SORRY THAT OVER HALF OF THE AUSTRIANS CHOSE TO SHOW THE WORLD THAT MORAL VALUES DO NOT COUNT. AS OF TODAY, THE ENTIRE AUSTRIAN PEOPLE ARE SHARING THE TERRIBLE SUSPICIONS RAISED AGAINST THEIR THIRD REICH OFFICER TURNED PRESIDENT.
