RADIO FRANCE-INTER BY CORRESPONDENT IN MOSCOW PAUL-MARIE DE LA GORCE: "THE DAY WAS VERY BUSY. ARMS CONTROL REMAINS A SOVIET OBSESSION. IT SEEMS THAT WE ARE CLOSE TO A SETTLEMENT OF THE 24 HUMAN RIGHTS CASES PRESENTED TO THE SOVIETS BY THE FRENCH FOREIGN MINISTER...."

RADIO EUROPE ONE WITH CORRESPONDENT IN MOSCOW, JEAN-MARIE LEFEVRE: "TWO HOURS AND FORTY-FIVE MINUTES OF TETE-A-TETE....FRANCE REFUSES TO MEDDLE IN THE (GENEVA) NEGOTIATIONS. FRENCH NUCLEAR FORCES ARE NOT NEGOTIABLE...."

INFLUENTIAL LE MONDE FRONT-PAGE REPORT BY SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT IN MOSCOW, JACQUES AMALRIC: "GORBACHEV IS A CLEVER MAN. AT A TIME WHEN RELATIONS WITH WASHINGTON SEEM TO BE IMPROVING, HE CAREFULLY AVOIDED MENTIONING THE U.S. AND SDI IN HIS TOAST TO MITTERRAND. FINALLY, HE MADE NO COMMENT ON THE STATE OF RELATIONS WITH WASHINGTON....ON THE OTHER HAND, IN HIS TOAST, MITTERRAND DID NOT FORGET THAT THE U.S.S.R. WAS A SUPERPOWER AND HE REFUSED TO ENDORSE THE MYTHICAL EUROPE WHICH STRETCHES FROM THE ATLANTIC TO THE URAL....BUT MITTERRAND COULD NOT IGNORE THE SOVIET PROPOSAL ON ARMS CONTROL REPEATED BY GORBACHEV.
